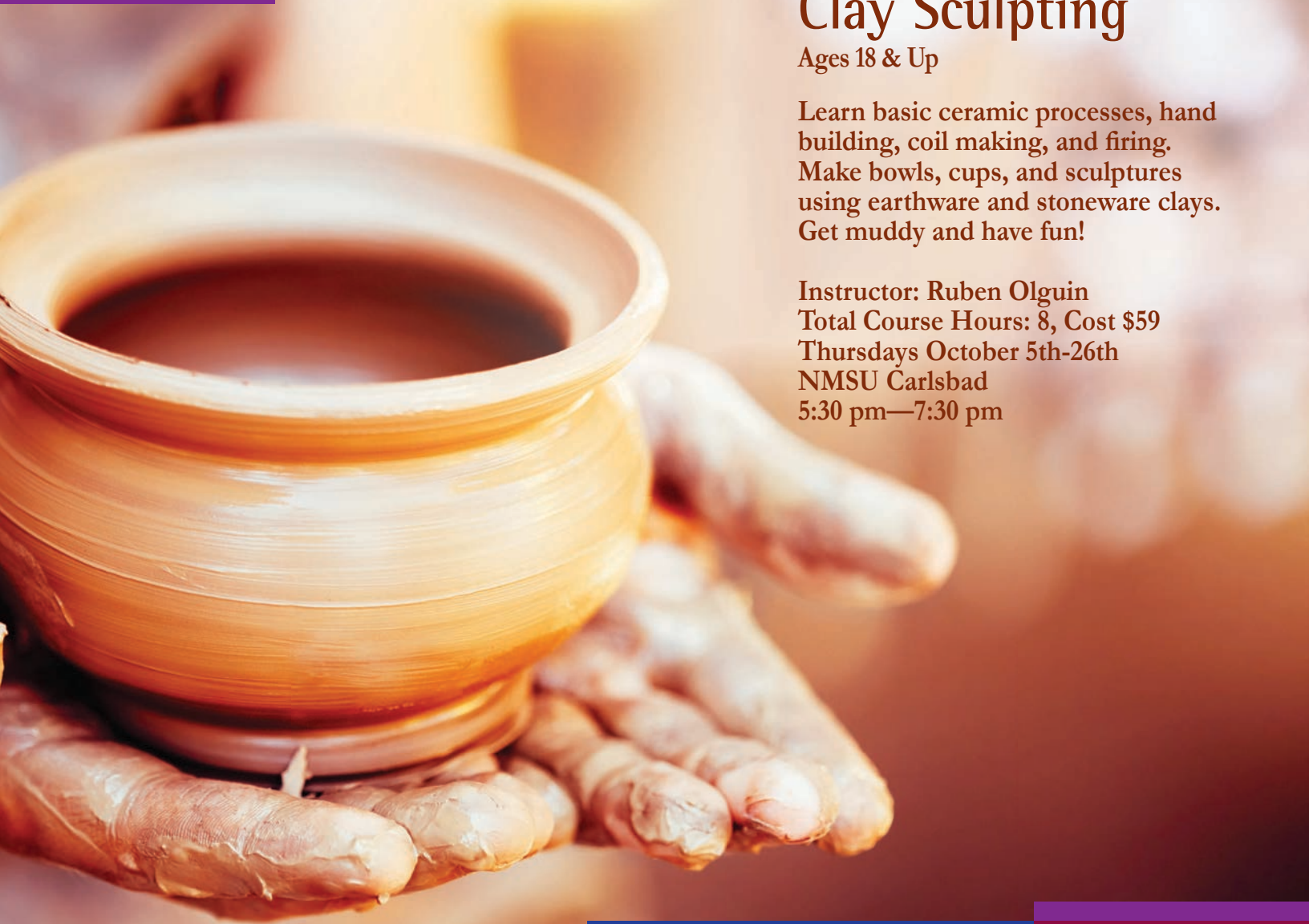

This class is an introduction to two internal arts used for healing and self-defense. The course will integrate physical

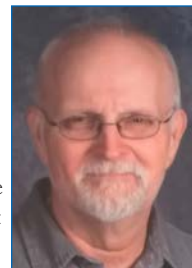
postures, breathing techniques, and help students focus intentions. No uniform is required, but please wear comfortable clothing that does not restrict movement.

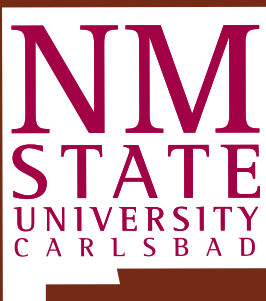
