Students who register and participate in the Dual Credit/Early Admissions Program will be expected to:

- Work independently without reminders
- Follow directions
- Abide by the course syllabus
- Deal with sophisticated concepts maturely
- Manage their study time and complete assignments
- Communicate personally with the instructor to discuss problems and questions
- Behave in a mature manner

Online courses: Students registered in an online course are responsible for setting up their my.nmsu accounts and contacting the Learning Technology Center or Dual Credit Coordinator to set up a CANVAS Orientation.

Financial Responsibility: Students enrolled in a dual credit/early admissions course will be financially responsible for all course fees and costs not covered by the program.

Other: Students are recommended by the high school principal/designee to enroll in dual credit/early admissions courses and must possess the maturity and academic ability necessary to attempt college-level course work.
